Tennis Club Membership: There was discussion about who can be a Tennis Club member. In accordance with the current club by-laws, the Club has two classes of membership:

-Full Members include those who own residential property within Tahoe Donner and their immediate family members (holders of amenity-access member identification cards);

-Associate Members shall be limited to long-term renters and those Tahoe Donner employees and concessionaire's personnel who qualify for court privileges. All Tahoe Donner property owners are eligible for membership in the Club so long as all Club dues are paid .

Based on these by-laws, non--homeowners who do not qualify as Associate Members, will not be permitted to be club members but can certainly join our events as guests and will pay the appropriate guest fees.

Updating Club Display Case: Our current case is badly in need of repair/replacement and Dick Fearon, who made the current display case, will re-build the case and charge the club for his work.

General: There was discussion about expanding the weekly round robin format to include women and mixed. The Board could provide beverages for these round robins. Men's 4.0 now has a drop in once a week organized by Ian. It was generally decided that the Board won't organize any round robin events now but will re-address the issue early next year.
